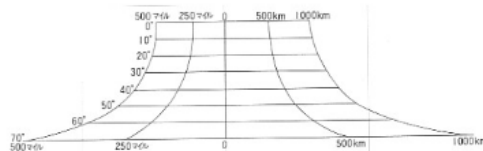
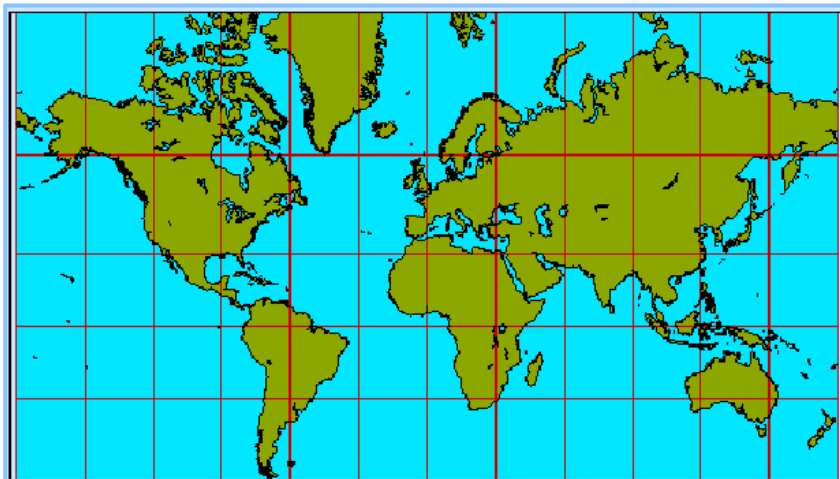

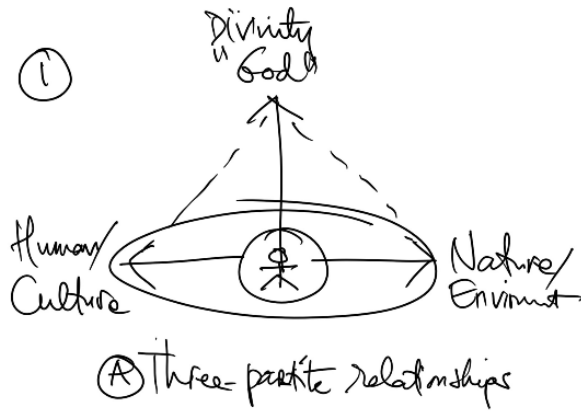
What is happening to our common home

7. Social-economic polarity, economic greed, corruption

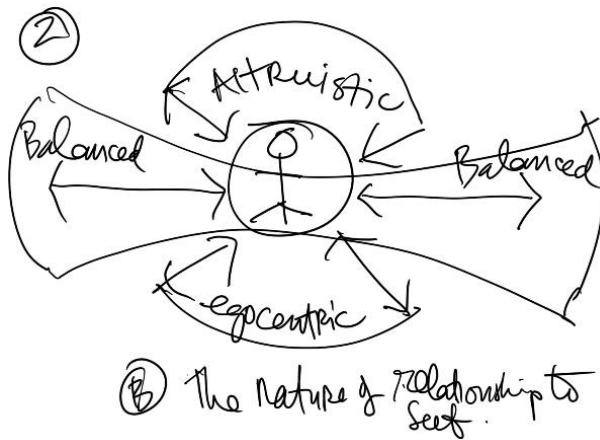
Repentance :

8. Be truthful to self and empathetic to all of God's creations

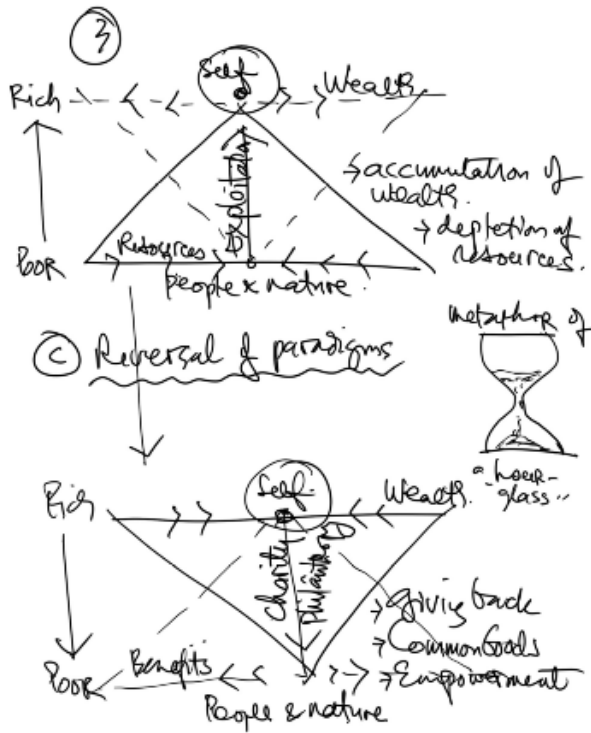
Tri-partite Relationships of Human Being to God, Nature & Culture



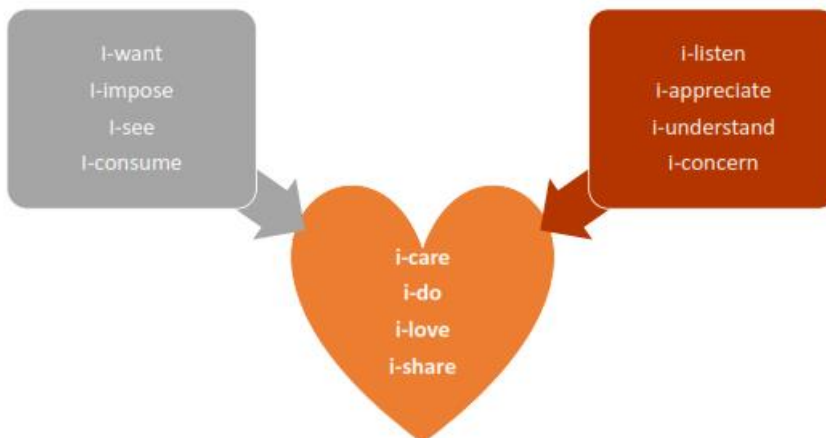

1. Ancient Gree

Reforming Education

1. Holistic education is a totality of affective (value/ethic) + cognitive (knowledge/intellect) + psychomotor (skill/aptitude) education
2. University education IS a problem based learning and a problem solving training
3. University education needs to develop both student's design capacity and research capacity

Restoring Pedagogy

1. From TEACHING to LEARNING
2. To synchronize Skill, Knowledge, and Ethic in a holistic education
3. Blended Learning
Blended learning is an education program (formal or non- formal) that combines online digital media with traditional classroom methods. It requires the physical presence of both teacher and student, with some element of student control over time, place, path, or pace

4. Flipped Classroom
Flipped classroom is an instructional strategy and a type of blended learning that reverses the traditional learning environment by delivering instructional content, often online, outside of the classroom. It moves activities, including those that may have traditionally been considered homework, into the classroom

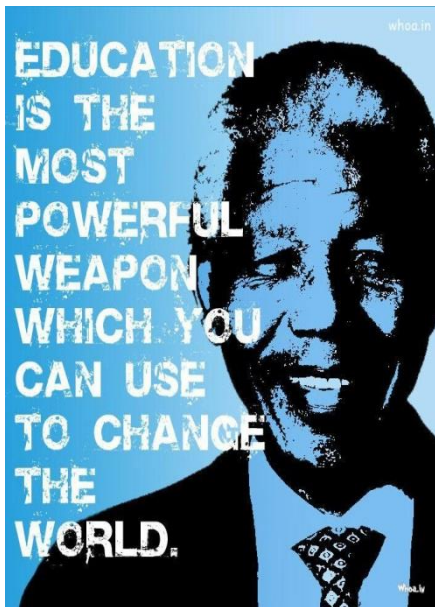
